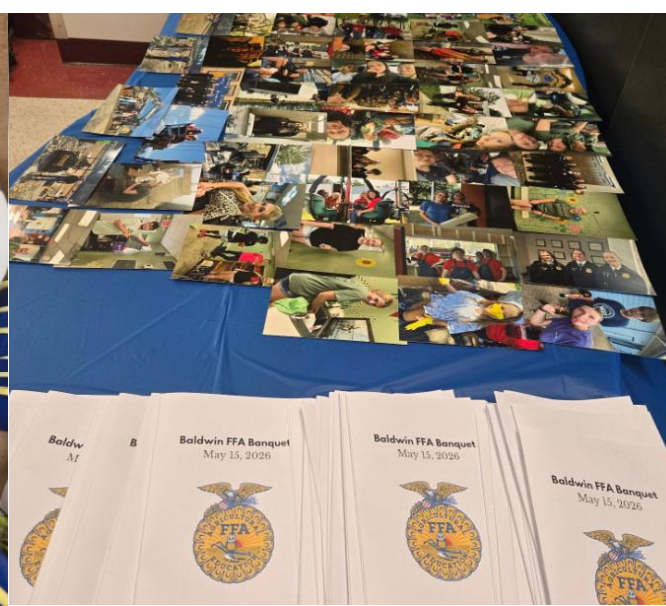
## Celebrations
